Mr. Enn

(Read or paraphrase)

(Stop Reading)

DO NOT REVEAL UNLESS ASKED:

You really are a very good person who is not capable of killing anyone. You are too humble to ever reveal this. You are probably the smartest one in the group. You have recently upset a lot of the others because you have been appearing on television speaking out against the others because you feel they are dishonest.

Mr. Enn Clue # 1

(Read or paraphrase)

I have discovered through my research that Judge Black is a part of an underworld gang that is trying to corrupt the government. He is the leader and has been accepting bribes from his friends to keep them out of jail. He has also shredded important documents to cover up crimes that his friend has committed.

Mr. Enn Clue # 2

(Read or paraphrase)

At the press conference I saw Sean Jones with something red on his pant leg. I asked him about it and he said he was out working and he got some red mud on his pants. He looked kind of nervous and hurried off.

Mr. Enn Clue # 3

(Read or paraphrase)

I know how badly Sean, the Judges brother, envied his position as Chief Justice. His dream was to become the next Chief Judge. I know he always wanted the position for himself. I believe he killed him so that he could have the position and power for himself, thus fulfilling his life long dream. I don't think that it was mud on his clothes, I think it was blood.

(Try to convince everyone that Sean is the murderer!)

About my Character:

Judge Black

(Read or paraphrase)

I am a great judge second in command only to the now dead Judge Jones. I think that I would make a great head judge. I am very sad to find out about Judge Jones death. I don't particularly like Mr. Enn. As a matter of fact I know some things that might be able to put him behind bars if only he weren't so popular. Oh by the way I have been known to accept favors from people but hey everyone is doing it.

(Stop Reading)

DO NOT REVEAL UNLESS ASKED:

You are very corrupt. You have accepted bribes from anyone who has money to spend. You hate Mr. Enn more than anyone in the world. He threatens you because he has the power to expose you to the world as being a major crook.

Judge Black Clue # 1

(Read or paraphrase)

Mr. Fife is a great employee. Basically he is a great worker because he will do anything I say. He works for me and for Judge Jones. We both gave him access to both our homes because we fully trust him as our employee.

Judge Black Clue # 2

(Read or paraphrase)

This afternoon I got an anonymous tip that someone heard Mr. Enn say that the Chief Justice was murdered. This was before the press conference. I immediately sent Mr. Fife to find out if this was true.

Judge Black Clue # 3

(Read or paraphrase)

I actually was eavesdropping on Mr. Enn so I heard him say with my own two ears that Judge Jones was dead. This was before the police revealed it at the press conference. The only way he would have known this was if he was involved in the murder himself. He was with me at the time of the murder, so I know he couldn't have actually stabbed him. I figure he hired someone else to commit the actual murder, but because it was all his idea I believe that Mr. Enn should be charged with the crime of murder! (Try to convince everyone that Mr. Enn is the murderer!)

About my Character:

Sean Jones, J.D.

(Read or paraphrase)

I am the brother of the Chief Justice. I loved my brother with all my heart, we were very close. I have spent my whole life building up a law practice that my older brother would be proud of. Now I am one of the best attorneys in town. You have probably seen me on T.V. or on the radio. I will miss my brother more than anyone will ever realize.

(Stop Reading)

DO NOT REVEAL UNLESS ASKED:

You really hate your brother. You are pretty broke because you lose more cases than you win. In fact if you didn't bribe the other judges in town you probably would never win. Luckily you have made a lot of money because you have helped get a lot of crooks out of jail and they have rewarded you very nicely.

Sean Jones, J.D. Clue # 1

(Read or paraphrase)

My brother was always very hard on his employees and that his maid was fed up with the poor treatment she was receiving. I would never treat anyone unfairly like he did. I heard Maid Marion was thinking of quitting because she hasn't received a raise in 5 years. She feared Judge Jones and was tired of his abuse.

Sean Jones, J.D. Clue # 2

(Read or paraphrase)

I organized the press conference announcing that my brother, the Chief Justice, had been murdered. I wanted it to be classy and on television so the world would know how great my brother was. It was the least I could do to honor his name.

Sean Jones, J.D. Clue # 3

(Read or paraphrase)

I heard Mr. Enn say that Judge Jones was dead before the press conference. I believe the only way Mr. Enn could have known that the Chief Justice was dead prior to its being made public in the press conference was if he was involved in the murder himself. More than likely he hired Mr. Malt to do kill Judge Jones. Mr. Malt has been pretty desperate for money so he was the one who would benefit the most from killing my brother. Since Mr. Malt was the "hit man" I believe Mr. Malt should be charged with murder! (Try to convince everyone that Mr. Malt is the murderer!)

About my Character:

Mr. Tom Mult

(Read or paraphrase)

I am an average citizen. I am not well known so I can do what I please without many people noticing me. Lately I have been a little down on my luck. Things at home haven't been the greatest. If it weren't for Mr. Enn I probably wouldn't have any friends.

(Stop Reading)

DO NOT REVEAL UNLESS ASKED:

You are not just a little down on your luck. You are flat broke. Mr. Enn is the only one in the group who has helped you at all. You respect Mr. Enn and try to help him any way you can.

Mr. Tom Mult Clue # 1

(Read or paraphrase)

I know that Mr. Enn and Judge Black don't get along. Judge Black is angry that Mr. Enn is in the process of exposing him and his corrupt group of friends. I think Judge Black would do anything to get revenge. I don't trust the Judge, he seems like the type of guy who would trip his own mother if she crossed him.

Mr. Tom Mult Clue # 2

(Read or paraphrase)

I happened to go by Judge Jones house and saw Mr. Fife lying next to the judges' dead body. I figured he had to be the murderer so I went to the police to have him arrested. I was pretty shaken up at the time so I don't remember much else.

Mr. Tom Mult Clue # 3

(Read or paraphrase)

Mr. Fife was there lying next to the dead Judge. I think he may have either been knocked out after a lengthy battle with the judge or he just fainted. Why else would he be there? He is the murderer. (Try to convince everyone that Mr. Fife is the murderer!)

About my Character:

Mr. Barney Fife

(Read or paraphrase)

I work for Judge Jones and for Judge Black. I am so good at my job that they have given me all access to everything they own. I must be so valuable to be entrusted with so much information. I can be counted on to do whatever is necessary to help either Judge. I want to go down in history as the best assistant in the world.

(Stop Reading)

DO NOT REVEAL UNLESS ASKED:

You really only like Judge Black, you think that Judge Jones is corrupt. Judge Black has been promising you all kinds of riches if you will do whatever he says. You will do whatever Judge Black says because you are very eager to please.

Mr. Barney Fife Clue #1

(Read or paraphrase)

I know that Mr. Mult knows of the fighting going on between Mr. Enn and my boss, Judge Black. I think Mr. Mult thinks very highly of Mr. Enn and would do anything to help him. I think he's a little desperate for money, more than he lets on. Maybe Mr. Enn is giving him money.

Mr. Barney Fife Clue #2

(Read or paraphrase)

I saw Maid Marion running from the house right after the murder. She was screaming "The Judge has been murdered! The Judge has been murdered!" as I was approaching the house. I am not sure if she was surprised or screaming for joy.

Mr. Barney Fife Clue #3

(Read or paraphrase)

Maid Marion has to be the murderer. She was running around right after the murder had taken place screaming that the Judge was dead. I believe she ran out screaming that the judge had been murdered in order to throw suspicion from herself. (Try to convince everyone that Maid Marion is the murderer!)

About my Character

Maid Marion:

(Read or paraphrase)

I work for Judge Jones. He can be a good boss but sometimes he can get a little difficult to work for. He had treated me fairly well although he hasn't given me a raise for quite some time now. From cleaning his house I do get to see some interesting people though.

(Stop Reading)

DO NOT REVEAL UNLESS ASKED:

You are not happy at all. You have wanted to quit for some time now but you know that if you do, Judge Jones would make sure you could never get a job again. You are kind of like a slave to the dead Judge. You are so happy that he is dead and are having a hard time trying to hide it. If people realize that you are really happy that the Judge is dead than feel free to express your joyfulness that the Judge is dead.

Maid Marion Clue # 1

(Read or paraphrase)

I know that the Judge's brother, Sean, is a liar when he says that he likes his brother. Sean is very jealous because his brother is successful and powerful, and Sean just isn't. Sean really wants to be Chief Justice himself.

Maid Marion Clue # 2

(Read or paraphrase)

As I was cleaning the house today I found the body lying in a pool of blood. I immediately ran out and starting telling everyone I saw in a ladylike manner. I did this to spread the word as quickly as possible.

Maid Marion Clue # 3

(Read or paraphrase)

I heard Judge Jones confront Judge Black about his involvement in a group conspiring to oust him from his office. I know that Judge Black is a crook and is very power hungry. I believe Judge Black killed Judge Jones so that he could have his seat and also to prevent Judge Jones from exposing and punishing Judge Black and his group.
