

You are the Private Investigator.

If you have an extra youth at the table, have them take on the role of the Private Investigator and let them steer the conversation.

Explain that they are taking on the role of these people, it is meant to be fun, and they can use their acting abilities, but they CANNOT lie about their character.

Make sure everyone has a name tag. There should be six suspects. Mr Enn, Judge Black, Sean Jones, J.D., Tom Mult, Maid Marion, and Mr. Fife.

Help generate discussions.

If someone is getting too much attention, try and get someone else to reveal something about someone else.

Give the group about 2 minutes to discuss it.

Have the youth read the clues in order, handing them out one at a time.

After the clues are given out have them discuss who they really feel is the murderer. Have them come up with an agreement on who they feel is the murderer, why, and how it happened.
