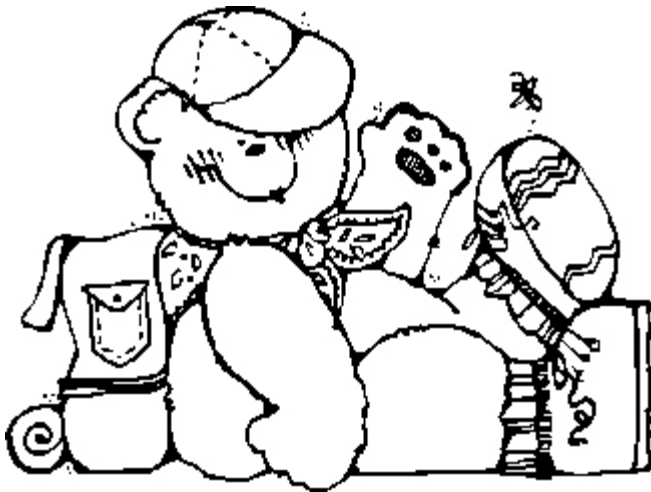


## Are You LDS?
